As you must have heard, the whole world is current worry about the outbreak of Coronavirus disease. The virus was first reported in Wuhan, China, on December 31st, 2019. In China, the numbers of deaths caused by Coronavirus went to 2 thousand on Feb, 19th. According to the website The Lancet, Coronavirus may have started with the bats. Although the analysis suggests that bats might be the original host of this virus, an animal sold at the seafood market in Wuhan might represent an intermediate host facilitating the emergence of the virus in humans. In the last update, Brazil had 2 confirmed cases, both in São Paulo and from passengers coming from Italy. There are already 60 affected countries, 2980 deaths and 87.161 confirmed cases in the world. KOBE BRYANT

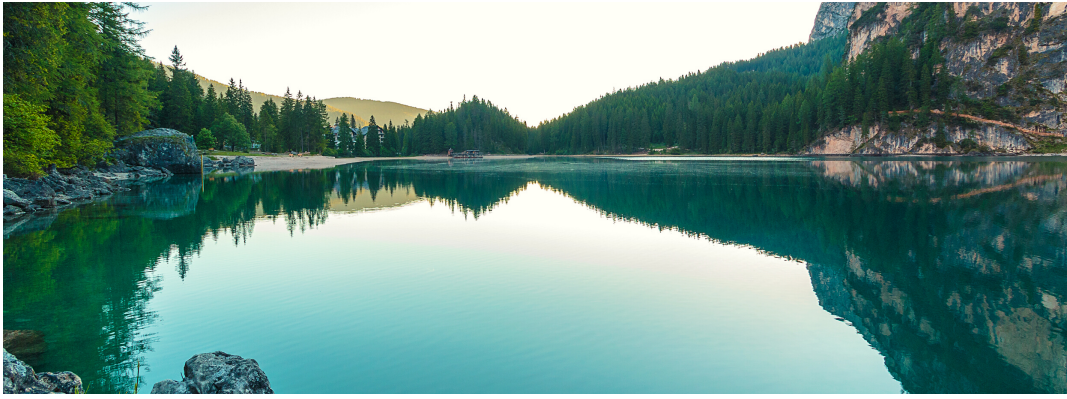
Kobe Bean Bryant was born on August 23th, 1978 and he died on January 26th, 2020, because of a helicopter crash. He had 4 daughters and one of them (Gianna Bryant) died in the accident. Kobe Bryant was an American professional basketball player of the National Basketball Association (NBA). Kobe Bryant won 5 NBA Championships, was an 18-time all-star, 15-time member of the all-NBA team, 12-time member of the all-defensive team, was named the 2008 NBA the most valuable player (MPV), and was 2 times NBA finals MPV winner.

The retired NBA legend player Kobe Bryant died in a helicopter crash in Foggy Mountain near Calabasas, California, on a Sunday morning. The helicopter dropped down because of a high-energy impact that made the vehicle fall about 30 miles (40 kilometers). The pilot decided to change the course. The helicopter was carrying: Kobe Bryant, his daughter, 6 family friends, including: the baseball coach John Altobelli, his wife, his daughter, and the pilot. All on board were killed. It is unclear why the helicopter fell at the speed like that, was too fast for a standard landing. Fans quickly gathered to pay their respect at the Staples Center where Bryant played.

Curiosities about the case:

- A school's principal had celebrated Kobe's death, and was therefore dismissed from employment. Her name is Lisa Sejkora, from a school in Camas, Washington.
- Kobe Bryant's wife was outraged by the police for having shared more photos of the accident.

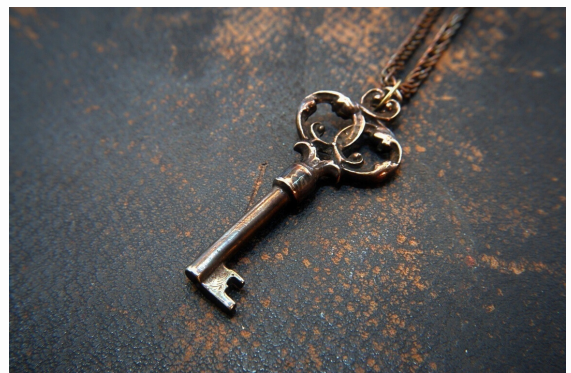
LOCKE & KEY
